Nami— National Alliance on Mental Illness. "To improve the quality of life, ensure dignity and respect for citizens of Summit County who have a mental illness, and offer support to their families.

NAMI offers Education Classes:

NAMI Basics - 6 week education class - Trained instructors assist families of children under 18 who are diagnosed with neurobiological/behavioral disorders of depression, bipolar, OCD, ADHD, and Autism. Classes explain medication therapies, and resources. Childcare is provided.

Family to Family - 12 week education class - Trained family instructors explain brain disorders, brain function, medications, coping and communication skills. Classes are for families and friends of persons experiencing mental illnesses.

Peer to Peer - 10 week education class - Trained peer instructors explain brain disorders, dual diagnoses, medications, empowerment, borderline personality disorder, relapse prevention. Skill training for those experiencing, or diagnosed with mental illnesses.
